School Day visits, program of events

<p>Large Group Demonstration</p>	<p>A demonstration of the Bushcraft Subject, designed to give insight to the skills necessary to thrive in the wilds, this will center around the setting of and making a camp with shelter, tools, fire, water and food all demonstrated using the 5 'C's our essential equipment, with some very modern and old skills thrown in for good measure.</p> <p>You will need to have space for this demonstration and outside seating for the students.</p> <p>If you wish this to be demonstrated in your assembly hall then adjustments will be necessary to ensure damage is not caused and fire alarms are not activated.</p> <p>WoodlandCPS Bushcraft School in both instances will need to visit your school prior to the day to ensure that any adjustments that are identified allowing time for those adjustments to be made.</p>

<p>Single Day introduction to Bushcraft</p>	<p>A full school's day (adjustable to the students taking part), you may wish to extend this day beyond the normal hours to enable the students to receive the full benefits available.</p> <p>You will need to have outdoor space for this activity and the students will require a packed lunch, WoodlandCPS Bushcraft School will provide all necessary items for up to 20 students, including, Shelters, Cutting tools, Containers, Combustion tools and Cordage and wood fuel.</p> <p>Please be advised due to the amount of administration needed for this activity there's a minimum limit of 10 Students and a maximum of 20.</p> <p>The students will receive a certificate to show they have undertaken a full 1-day introduction into Bushcraft.</p> <p>WoodlandCPS Bushcraft School will need to visit your school prior to the day to ensure that your area chosen is sufficient and identify any adjustments required prior to the day.</p>

WoodlandCPS Bushcraft School can visit your school for pre-arranged days where the core subjects of Bushcraft are taught in two ways:

1. As a demonstration to a large group with individual interaction throughout (if this is inside please remember the restrictions this will cause to Fire Lighting and Game Preparation). The total cost to the school for this activity is £320.

2 As a set 1-day course to a small group of students 20 max where the core subjects of Shelter, Fire, Water, Food and tool use will be covered. The total cost for a student completing this activity is £20 per student.

The only additional cost to the School is the reimbursement of fuel/travel costs, an itemised bill of these costs will be sent to the school on completion of the activity within 5 working days.
