The total cost for a student completing this activity if it is a 6-week program including quiz week is £33.00 per student.

The total cost for a student completing this activity if it is a 7-week program including the tool 2 week is £37.00 per student.

The total cost for a student completing this activity if it is a full 8-week program including separate bushcraft knots and Shelter weeks is £41.00 per student.

The only additional cost to the School is the reimbursement of fuel/travel costs an itemised bill will be sent to the school on completion of the program each half term.
